## WHITES

### **Wolf Blass, Chardonnay, Australia 26.00**

Tropical fruit aromas of melon and peach on the nose. These fruity flavors are balanced by clean acidity, subtle oak and good length.

### **Montes, Classic Chardonnay, Chile 20.00**

Intense fruit aroma. A peachy wine with good body and balance. A touch of creaminess in mid palate, with a smooth elegant finish.

### **Clos du Bois, Chardonnay, California 25.00**

This medium bodied wine boasts ripe pear, citrus and vanilla flavors. Partial malolactic fermentation adds a rich, buttery texture, while aging sur-lie lends complexity and depth.

### **Santa Rita Sauvignon Blanc 120, Chile 16.00**

Intense, fragrant and fruity sauvignon redolent of peach, apple and pear. Inviting with pleasant acidity and vibrant finish.

### **David Bruce Chardonnay, Santa Cruz, California 30.00**

A beautiful Chardonnay, offering crisp flavors of toast, apples and flint, lending orange and apricot characters.

### **Wente 'Morning Fog' Chardonnay , CA 21.00**

Aromas and flavors of green apple and tropical fruits, balanced by subtle oak, cinnamon and vanilla from barrel aging. Delivers a medium-long, refreshing finish.

### **Meridian, Sauvignon Blanc, California 19.00**

Light intensity with flavors of fresh melon and crisp apple, with subtle floral notes and hints of oak.

### **Campanile, Pinot Grigio, Italy 21.00**

A blend primarily of Pinot Grigio grapes, but small amounts of Chardonnay and Pinot Bianco were added to balance the structure and add creamy apple-vanilla flavors.

### **King Estate, Pinot Gris, Oregon 27.00**

Delicate, fragrant aromas of apple blossom and herbs. Clean, balanced, varietal flavors of just sliced apple and baking spice.

### **Coppola Presents, Bianco, California 18.00**

100% Pinot Grigio. A crisp and refreshing wine with distinct melon and citrus flavors.

### **Funf 5 Riesling, Germany 13.00**

It's light, fruity and well-balanced with a fresh, clean finish. Loads of citrus character and great acid.

### **Relax Riesling, Mosel, Germany 19.00**

Forward fruit with floral aromas of apples and peaches and a hint of citrus. Refreshingly crisp and mouth watering.

## REDS

### **Seven Deadly Zins, California 36.00**

This wine is made with seven different grapes. It's not just another bottle with a quirky name...this wine is good.

### **Misterio Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 20.00**

Soft, fresh, and full-bodied with notes of red berries, plum, spice, black pepper and mint.

### **Greg Norman, Shiraz, Australia 26.00**

Bright and lively with its distinctive blueberry, plum and smoky aromas and flavors. Lingers with elegance and hints of sweet spice on the finish.

### **Wente 'Southern Hills' Cabernet Sauvignon , CA 19.00**

Cherry, dark plum and a hint of coffee. Rich, yet with approachable tannins provide a long smooth finish.

### **Shooting Star Merlot, Lake County, California 25.00**

Aromas of dark fruits and ripe Bing cherries. Lots of good fruit flavors and a touch of oak rounds things out.

### **Estancia, Cabernet, California 29.00**

Black currant, plum and blackberry flavors with mineral and cedary oak notes. Mocha tones slide through the finish.

### **Bogle Merlot, California 18.00**

Subtle and silky, yet bright and intense. Dark plum fruit greets the nose, while fruit of summer cherry dazzles the palate.

### **Franciscan Oakville, Magnificat, California 78.00**

70% cabernet sauvignon, 29% merlot, 1 % petite verdot. Deep, ripe fruit characters with hints of vanilla and spice.

### **Santa Ema, Reserve Merlot, Chile 23.00**

Plum and blackberry mixed with chocolate and toasted coffee notes and a ruby red color. Toffee notes with mature tannins.

### **Tamas Double Decker Red, Central Coast, CA 17.00**

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah and Barbera. Mouth-filling flavors of blackberry, black cherry and plum.

### **Harlow Ridge, Pinot Noir, California 17.00**

A complex medium bodied wine in which black cherry and wild berry flavors are balanced by toasty oak nuances.

### **Charles Krug, Pinot Noir, California 41.00**

Aged in French Oak, cedar and spice with hints of cloves and plum. One of the most sought after grapes of 2005.

### **Castle Rock Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon 23.00**

On the palate the wine give flavors of berries, cinnamon, black cherry, sweet vanilla oak, floral notes, with a velvety finish.

### **Bogle Old Vine Zinfandel, California 29.00**

Rich black raspberry notes and summer fruit jam bubbling on the stove with juniper berry and cinnamon stick.
